## This Month's Featured Supplier: Old Globe Reclaimed Wood Company

Old Globe Reclaimed Wood Company is taking down the historic Globe Elevator on the Duluth-Superior Harbor, which was once the biggest grain elevator in the world. It contains 6 million board feet of antique, old-growth lumber. (Read: they're not likely to run out in the middle of your project.)



The Old Globe wood -- both dimensional lumber and hefty timbers -- is primarily Eastern White Pine, a quintessential American species and a favorite of custom woodworkers. It is FSC-certified and qualifies for LEED points in several categories. A certificate of authenticity accompanies each order.

Old Globe offers a unique line of handcrafted, hand-rubbed flooring, paneling and architectural millwork. Most products are hand sanded to preserve the original character of the 1880s lumber, with its circular saw marks, square nail holes, ferrous stains, and other signs of its previous life.

Among the company's most unique products are bin walls sculpted by 100 years of flowing grain. Old Globe salvages those walls intact and offers them for wainscoting, accent walls, bar fronts, and other specialty applications. Some of those pieces were installed recently in a Starbucks in Chicago, the Convention Center in Duluth, and an architectural office in Minneapolis.

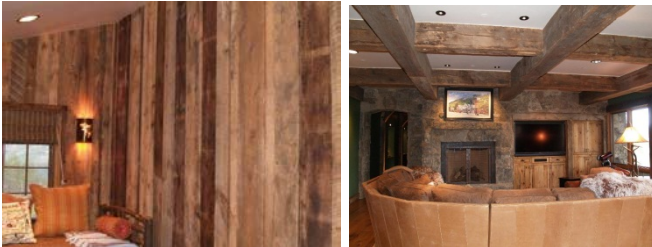
